



What makes teaching a difficult task? Being a class teacher for a new class in a new school? Some say “yes” and some just smile. Implementing a new and packed curriculum? Some agree and some shake their heads. How about handling students with disruptive behavior? Yes! So, what are we going to do with these ‘naughty’ students?

First, we have to look at the types for their misbehavior. They vary from student to student. Nine of the most challenging behaviors discussed in the book include students with disruptive disorders, students with anxiety disorders, students who are depressed or bipolar, students with eating disorders, students who bully and are bullied, students who are the victims of bias in the classroom, students who are survivors of suicide, students with high-functioning autism and social skills deficits and students with impulsivity. They are addressed by the following three approaches: Positive Behavioral Intervention and Supports (PBIS), mindfulness and the Life Space Interview (LSI) introduced in the book.
